
Pastor Wendy will be in as able,; Mary will be in Mon., Tues. pm, Wed., Thurs.



COMMEMORATIONS FOR THE WEEK:

Teresa of Avila, teacher, renewer of the church, died 1582 Wednesday, October 15, 2025

A mystical writer and reformer of the monastic order (Carmelites) to which she belonged, Teresa may also be commemorated with John of the Cross on December 14. Latino Christians traditionally remember her on this date

Ignatius, Bishop of Antioch, martyr, died around 115 Friday, October 17, 2025

Ignatius was the second bishop of Antioch in Syria, the city where the name "Christians" originated. Ignatius is known to us from his letters, which encouraged Christians to live in love, yet stand firm in true doctrine.

Luke, Evangelist Saturday, October 18, 2025

Identified as the author of both Luke and Acts, Luke was careful to place the events of Jesus' life in their social and religious contexts. His gospel gives us some of the most beloved parables, as well as the songs of Zechariah, Mary, the angels, and Simeon.
